BHSC MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

1. Pool admittance is subject to dues payment.
2. The following TWO forms must be on file:
 - Membership information and health update form
 - Member dues invoice/payment and service requirement form

(The membership service requirement provides an opportunity to choose between paying an increased dues amount or volunteering to perform services, which reduces costs and contributes to a positive view of the pool and grounds to members and the community. Unfulfilled service commitments are subject to a \$50 financial payment.)

Contact the President (Kurtis Swope, 443-852-5746, swope@usna.edu) or Mowing Coordinator (Kevin Hoover, rkhoover7@verizon.net), as appropriate, as your work date approaches to confirm your availability for the volunteer activity.

3. Members are immediate family or individuals who reside at the member address. No admittance without a picture of family/individual members on file. Pictures must be no more than two years old. A picture must be on file for each person on your membership.
4. **Neighbors or friends/relatives living close-by cannot be defined as guests** (this practice undermines membership as local residents have the option of becoming members.

Child Care providers may be registered when no adult family member is at the pool. A guest fee will be due for the care provider if an adult family member is present.

5. **Guest Fee:** Your first five guests are free with a paid membership. Additional guests are \$5 each, and guest passes in groups of five (\$25) can be purchased by check sent to the pool Treasurer or delivered to a Board Member at the pool. Paid, but unused, guest passes will carry over from year to year. A record of paid guest passes and usage is maintained at the pool.
6. Sign in with your first and last name upon arrival to the pool. A record of who is present is necessary to contact family, host members, or for emergency response personnel.

The host is to sign in each guest and inform the guard of guests. Names are needed to enforce the “Members Only” policy, for fee collection, and to manage guests through host members. Members must be present with guest(s) and are responsible for their guest’s compliance with pool rules. No guest may sign in on your membership if you are not at the pool.
