11:30 a.m. to 8 p.m.

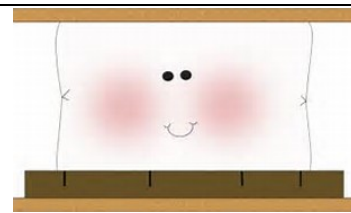
August 24th through Labor Day

Inclement weather/colder temperatures

Closures for inclement weather are necessary for both safety and financial reasons. Closing during questionable weather hours or days (when pool attendance is likely to be negligible) allows us to adequately staff the pool with lifeguards during high-attendance periods and maintain membership dues as low as possible. Email notifications of pool closures will be sent whenever possible. Inevitably, there will likely be a few days when the sun comes back out, but the pool is closed. Call the pool to check if it is open. If no answer, it is closed! If thunder occurs, the pool is evacuated (for 30 minutes after the last occurrence). If lightning occurs, the pool is closed and everyone must leave the premises.
